

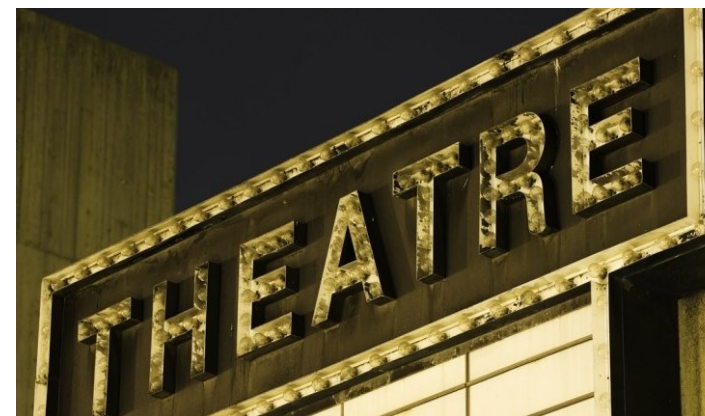
## Year 5 Trips 2024-2025
