In addition to this, learning another language raises awareness of our multi-lingual and multi-cultural world and introduces an international dimension to pupils' learning, giving them an insight into their own culture and that of others. Languages lessons enable children to access different cultures and languages they may not otherwise be exposed to and provide children with life skills which are applicable in a vast variety of situations in a real-world setting. The learning of a foreign language also creates a medium for cross-curricular links and for reinforcement of knowledge, skills and understanding developed in other subjects.
