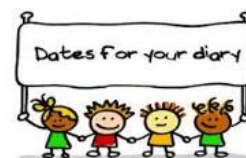
A big thank you to each and every one of you who made this week so special and memorable; we can't wait to see how Beavers continues to grow in the future.
