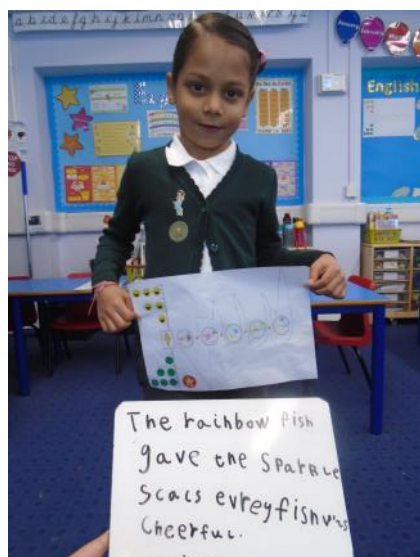

Christian from Sunshine Class had a lovely time playing on the field with Chrissie as a reward for making good choices.



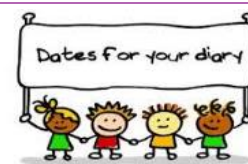
