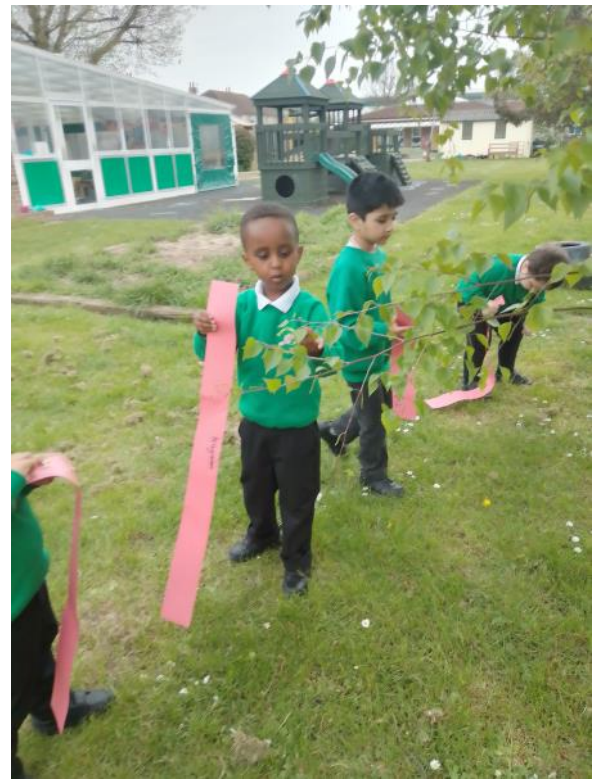
Teachers will be handing out the letters. Places are limited so return as soon as possible.
