to Delvin, Chris and Sanvi for their fantastic efforts and thank you to Mrs Bentley for organising this.



The French Shores




Year 2 have been learning about how orangutans are becoming endangered due to deforestation for palm oil, and what we can do to help. The children have been designing these lovely posters.
