

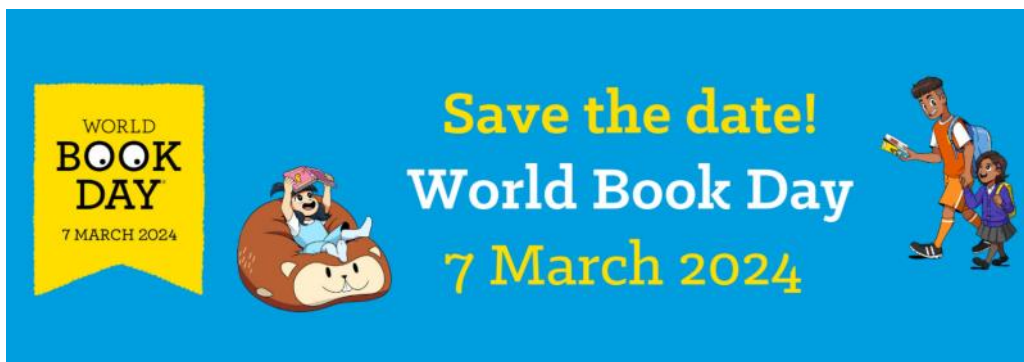

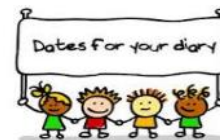

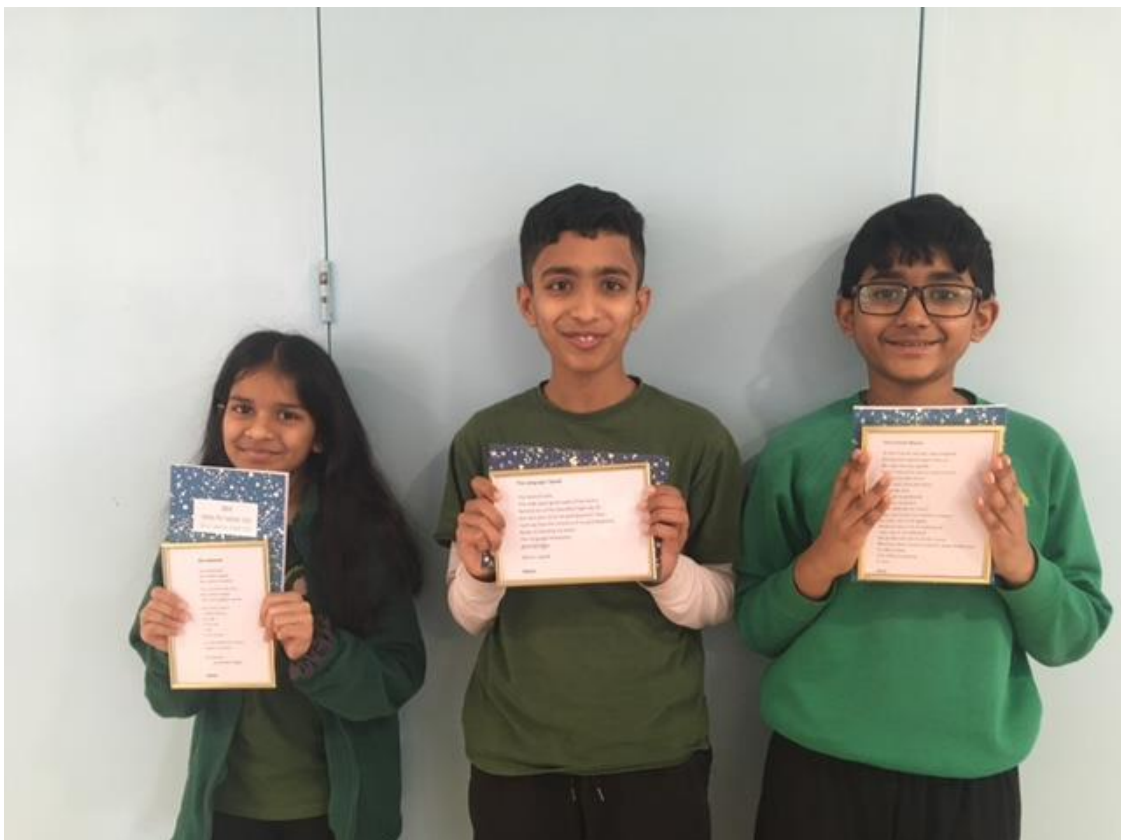
At the French shores I see seagulls
