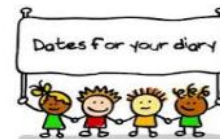

SEND Play Sessions at Snakes & Ladders

The facilities on offer at Snakes & Ladders are designed to encourage children to play, explore and test their limits at their own pace. The sessions are dedicated to children aged 0-12 years with special educational needs or disabilities provide a relaxed atmosphere where families can connect.

- FREE admission for up to 2 adults and 2 children (including at least one SEN/D child)
- Additional siblings or adult carers of your SEN/D child are also welcome to join the fun with discounted admission. A valid DLA letter must be shown on arrival
- Sessions run on Wednesdays 16:15-18:15 during term time, May school half term and during the school summer holidays (subject to change and availability).

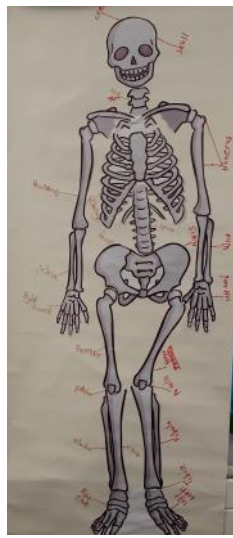

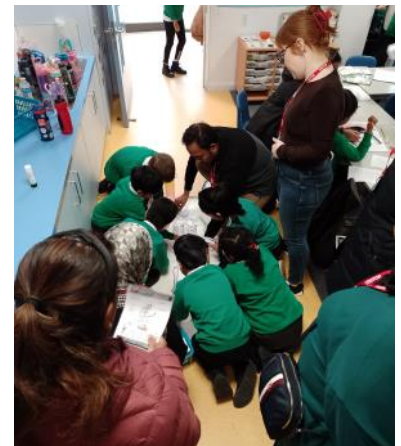
