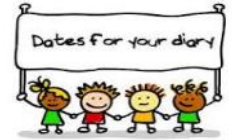

During Art's Week, **Sunshine** class enjoyed many activities related to their topic—Pet Grooming Salon. Rainbow class have had lots of fun this week creating their circus for Art's Week.

Reception's theme for Arts week was 'The Circus'. Staff dressed up and performed acts for the children. The children had so much fun. We had a special performance from the clown 'Silly Billy. The strong man/juggler, the ringmaster, double trouble and clown Townend. Children took part in various circus themed activities and created their own class models of a circus.

The **Nursery** children have had a lovely Arts Week! The children have been busy looking at different farm animals. They have been milking our pretend cow, creating a farmhouse, using clay to make pig faces and using different media to create their chicks. Well done Nursery!





Year 4s art theme was forged money. They were sent a box of bank notes from the Bank of England! And had a forensic workshop to see if the money was real or not.



This week, the Year 5 pupils drew inspiration from the Heath and created animal masks. The pupils used cereal boxes, feathers, sticks and leaves to create texture.
