Year 6 have created a display on being honest - our value for this term.



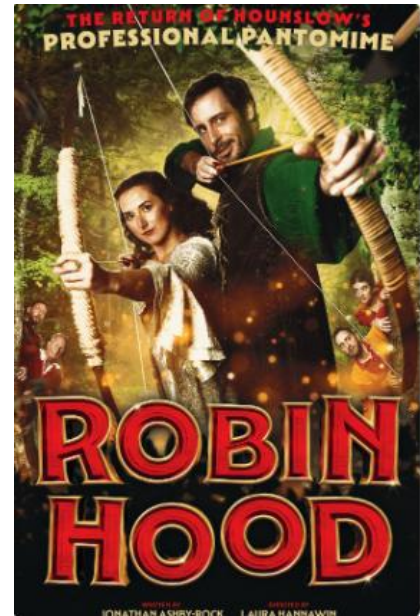


Children in years 1 to 6 have been going to the Paul Robeson Theatre to see the production of Robin Hood.

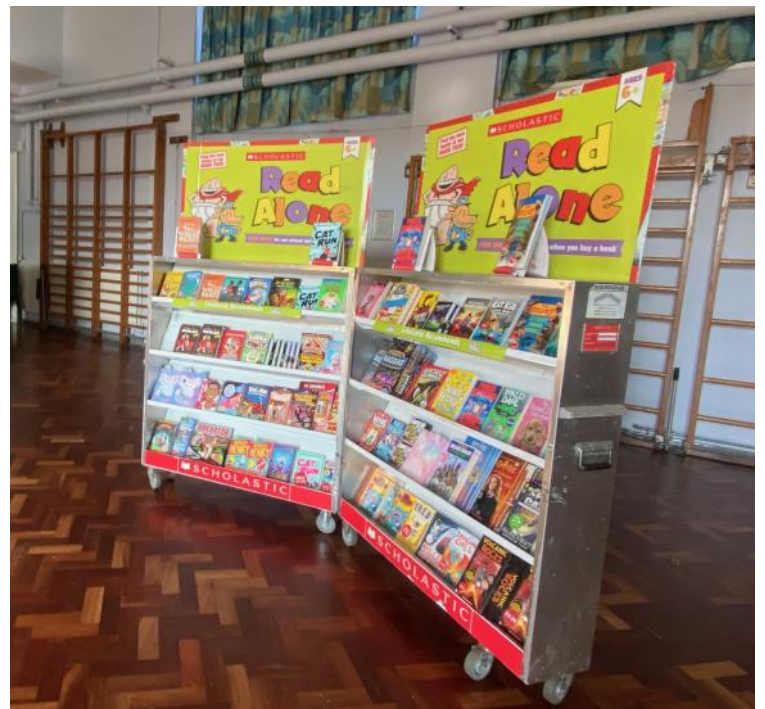

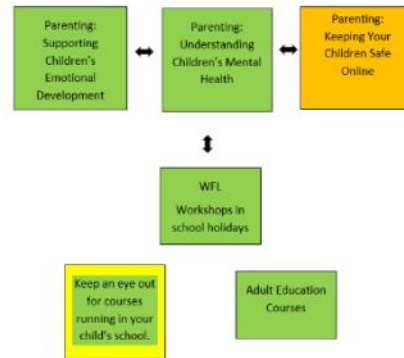

Please note: To successfully complete this course you must commit to 100% attendance and punctuality.

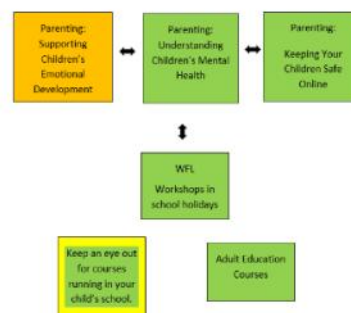
