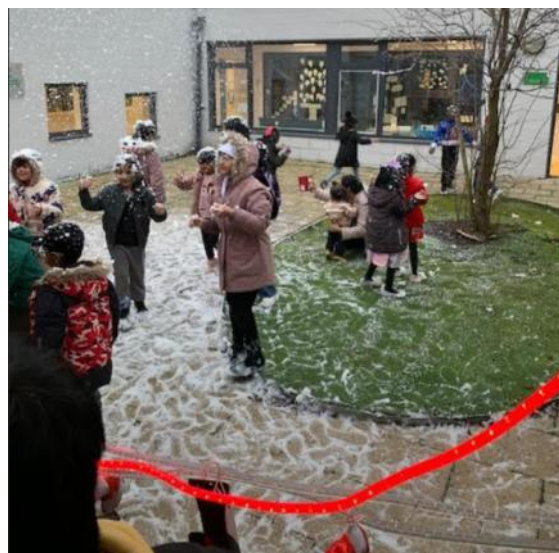

Christmas Fayre 2024



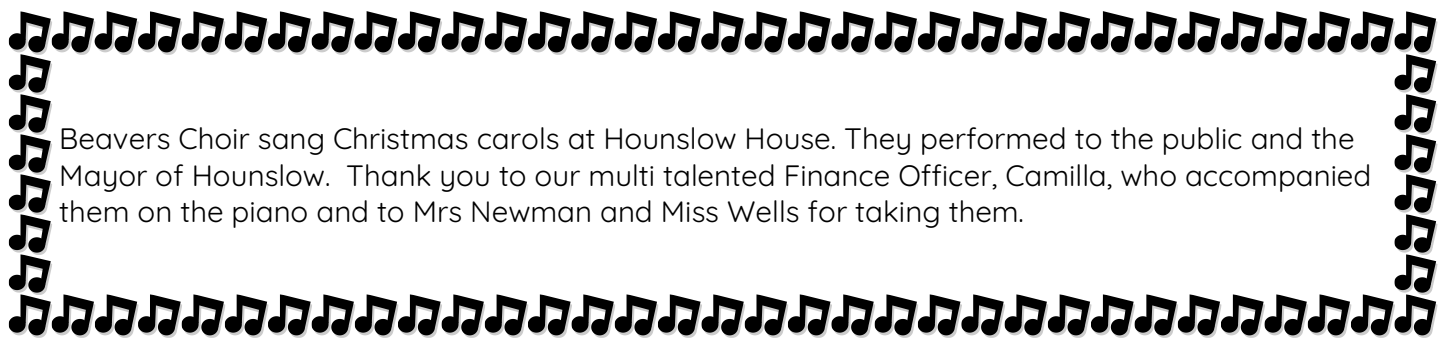
