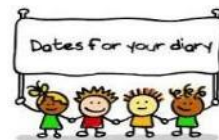

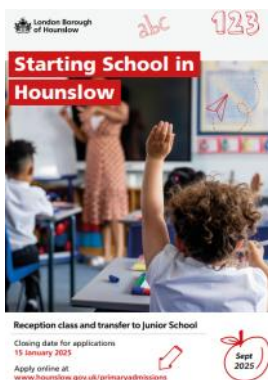
Nursery Admission: Children start Nursery in the September following their third birthday and spend three school terms at nursery before starting primary school. We offer places for 15 hours, either Morning (8.30am - 11.30am) or Afternoon (12.30pm - 3.30pm).

Children born between 01.09.2021 and 31.08.2022 will be eligible to start Nursery in September 2025. Applications must be received by **7th March 2025** and you will be advised of the outcome by 2nd May 2025.

Changes to Gooddies delivery

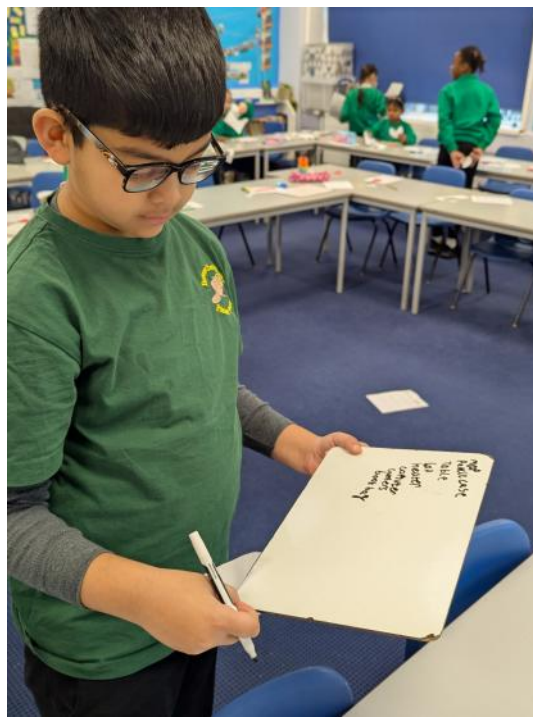
