About the Workshop:

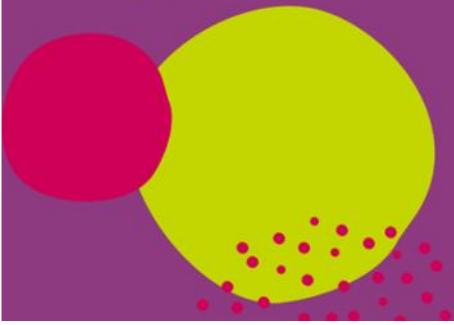

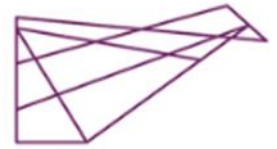
#### What is required to join the session?
