

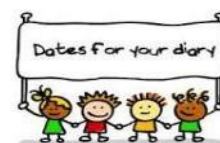

For World Maths Day the Nursery children had a great time looking for shapes and numbers in the Nursery garden.

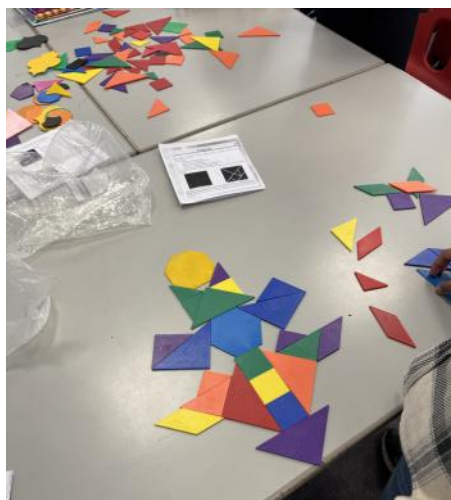
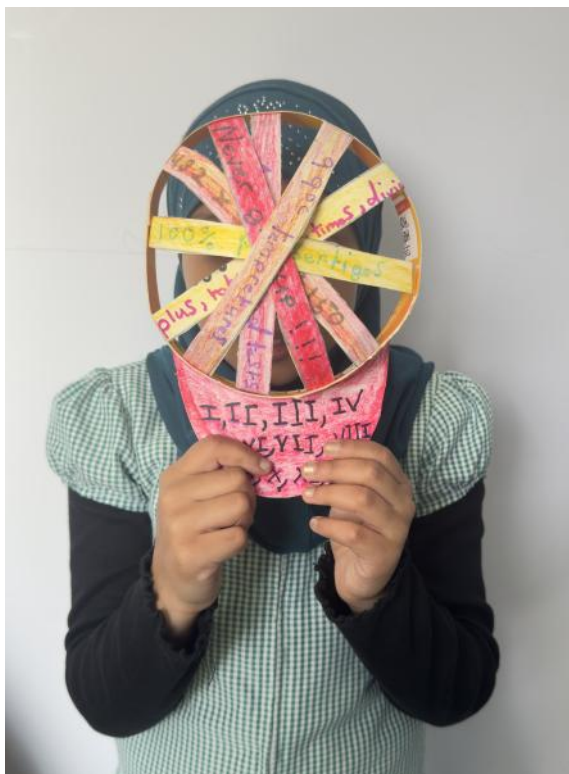
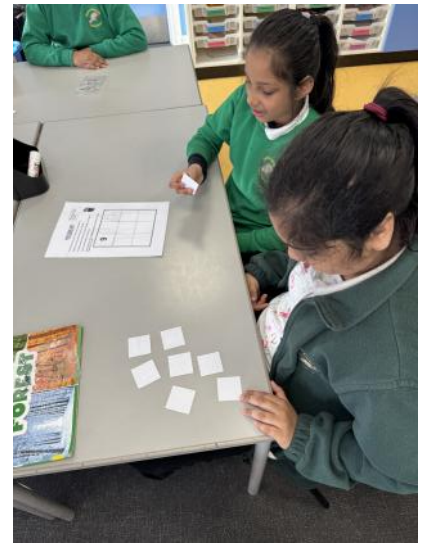




Year 3 enjoyed being palaeontologists in Science and learning about Mary Anning.

Year 6 created beautiful Mother's Day and Eid cards.



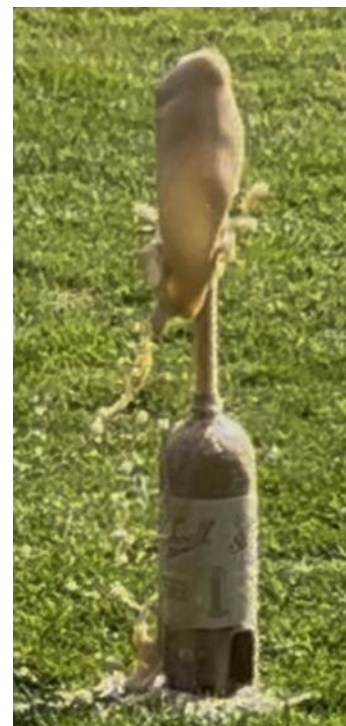
Reception classes enjoyed playing with numbers for World Maths Day.
