

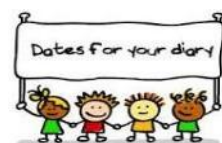

Who is eligible for Universal Credit childcare costs

- Starting a job in the next month

If you live with a partner, you both need to be in paid work, unless your partner cannot look after your children.

This includes holiday clubs, after-school clubs and breakfast clubs if you live with your partner. However, you cannot claim unless your partner cannot look after your children.
