

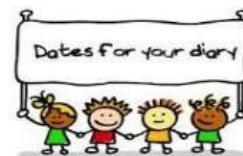

Antarctic Ice

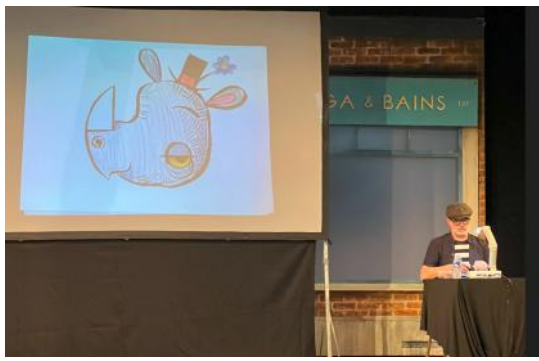
By Jude, Year 6

A bypass of brain teasers

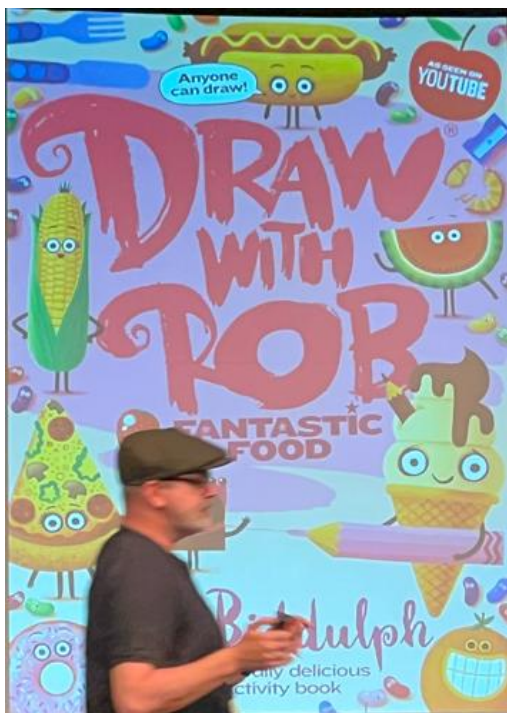
At Breaktime
