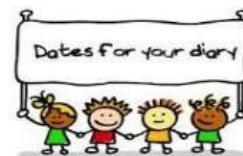

The weather is forecast to be very warm over the weekend and through to **6pm on Tuesday 1st July**. An Amber Heat

Health Alert is in place for London.

We want to reassure families that the school is taking all necessary precautions in line with our heat risk assessment. These include:

- Staying indoors or in shaded areas as much as possible
- Reorganising learning spaces, including potential classroom moves
- Adjusting PE sessions and outdoor play
- Monitoring indoor temperatures and ventilation
- Using pedestal fans where necessary

- Has a refillable water bottle
- Wears light, breathable clothing (they will not need jumpers)
- Has sun cream applied at home in the morning

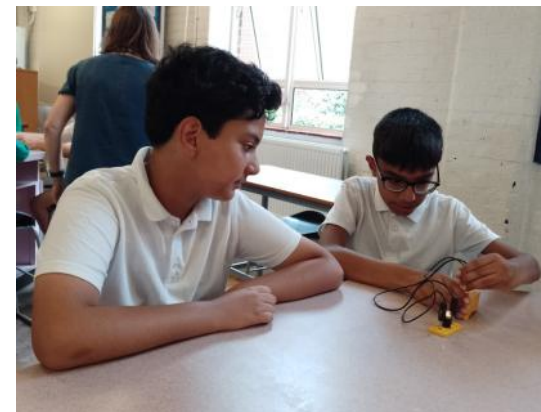
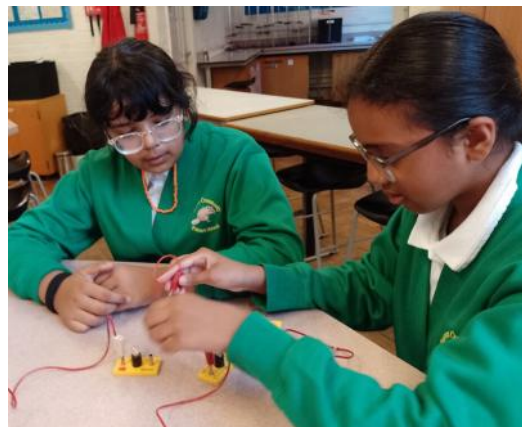




During sports week, the Nursery looked at healthy vegetables. The children enjoyed cutting the vegetables. They cooked vegetable pasta. It was delicious!
