

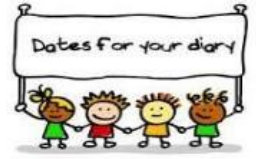

Our focus is on helping children with their reading.

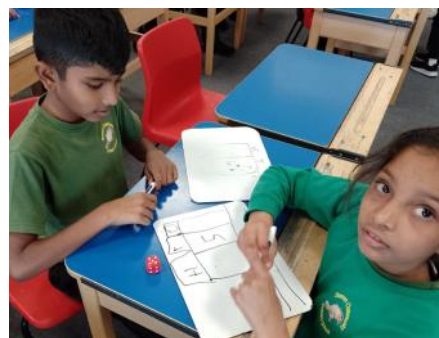

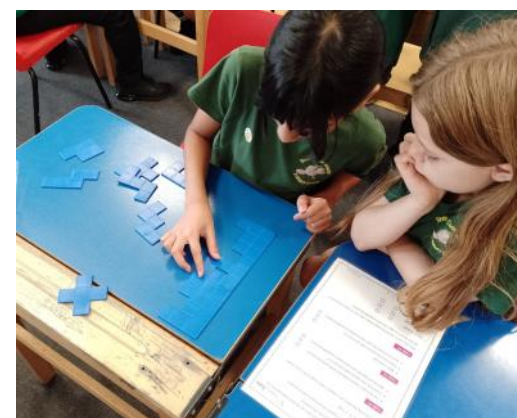


Year 4 created mosaic tiles inspired by our school values. Each student was given a letter to design and together the tiles spell out keywords that reflect what we stand for.

School Admission Applications for September 2026 are now open

Year 6 Secondary Transfer: Year 6 secondary school applications are to be submitted through e-admissions on the London Borough of Hounslow's website. The deadline to apply is 31st October 2025. Most schools have open days, see list above, so please try to visit as many as possible.

Reception Admission: If your child was born between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022 they will start reception in September 2026. Applications are to be submitted through e-admissions on the London Borough of Hounslow's website. The deadline to apply is 15th January 2026.
