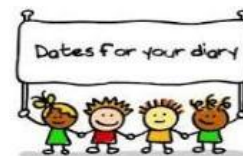

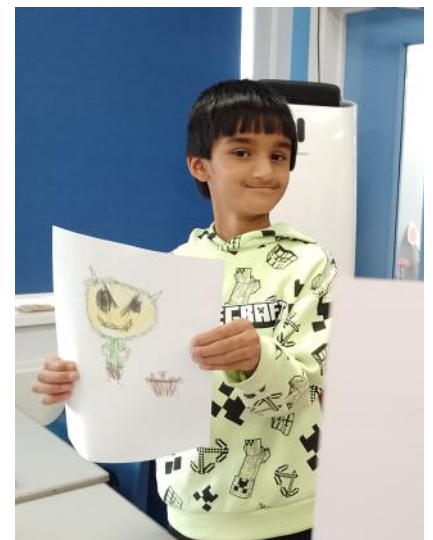


Year 1 went out onto the field and made nature bracelets. We had lots of fun and found Miss Ames favourite flowers.

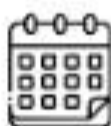

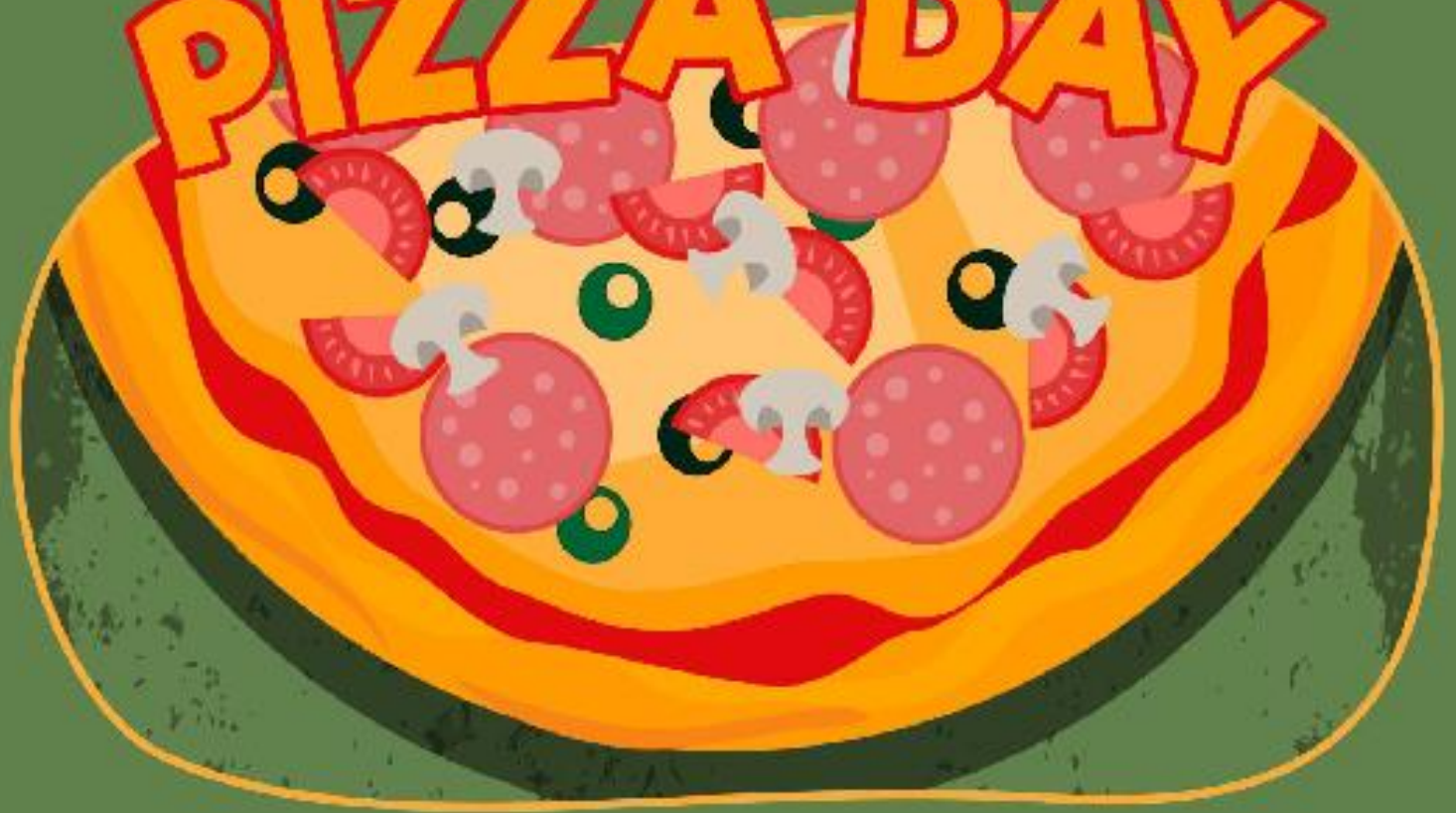
