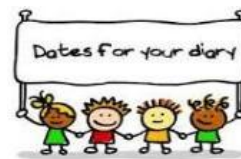




NEWSLETTER

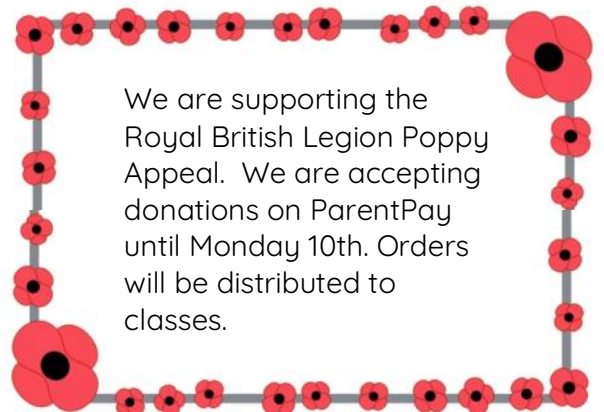
Free event - just turn up on the day!

Chrissie, our Dog Mentor, has been working hard on sitting on her carpet space this week and enjoying learning with the children in Blue Class.

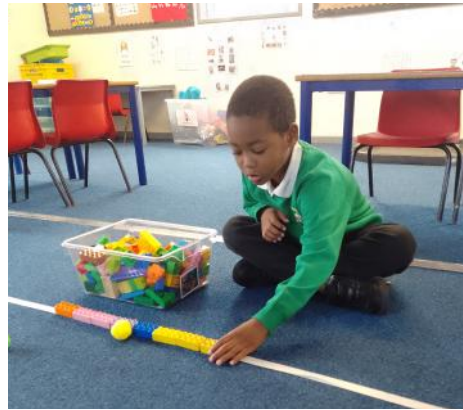
