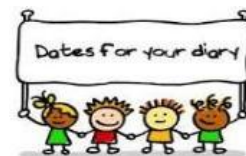


NEWSLETTER

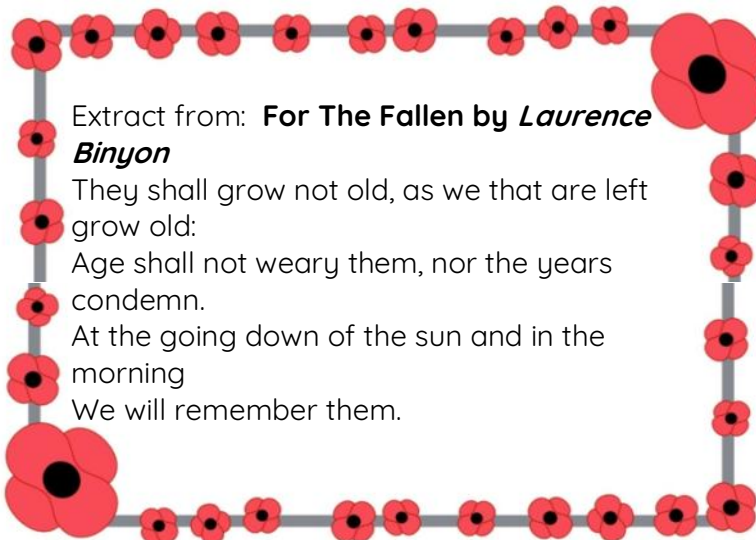

The children also enjoyed decorating biscuits using icing sugar and smarties. They had lots of fun!

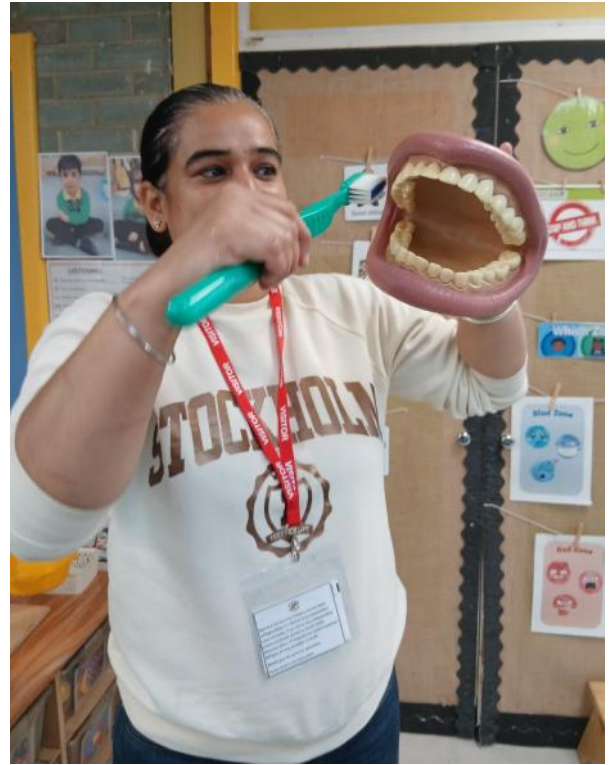




Year 4 had a great time taking part in the strictly dance challenge for Children in Need! They were very proud of perfecting the
