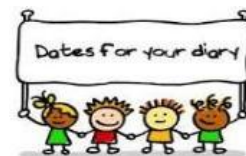

They created placards and held a peaceful protest asking for humans and aliens to live together in peace and harmony.

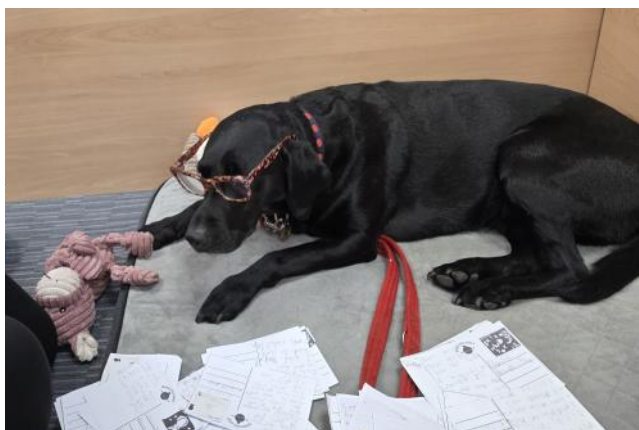


Year 4 had a fabulous time creating aliens for art weeks
