This week we tried an activity called **“The Floor Is Lava”** with Rainbow Class and a few children from Nursery. The children were very engaged and motivated, and they loved the physical challenge of balancing across the chairs while enjoying mark-making opportunities. Everyone joined in and explored mark making in their own way, making it a fun and active learning experience.



Years 2 & 5 had amazing workshops by the Fire Brigade about how to spot hazards in the home and stay safe in case of a fire. Year 5 learned about how to charge electronics safely, not to leave the cooker on unattended, that there are 102 fire stations in London, how closing a door can help stop a fire from spreading and to alert someone as quickly as possible when a fire does break out.
