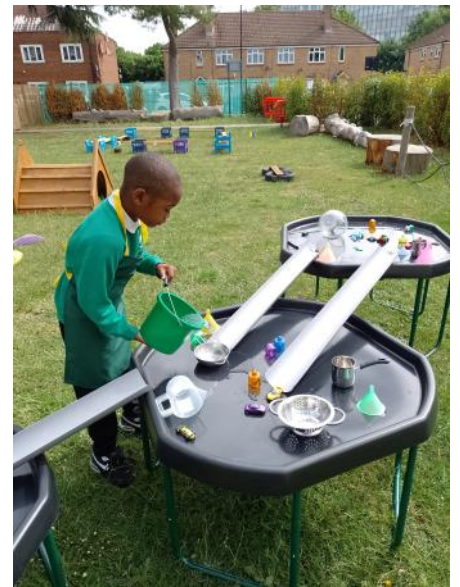

## The Young People's Poetry Competition needs you!

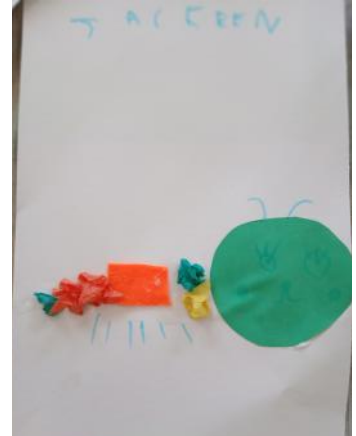

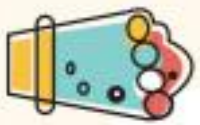
