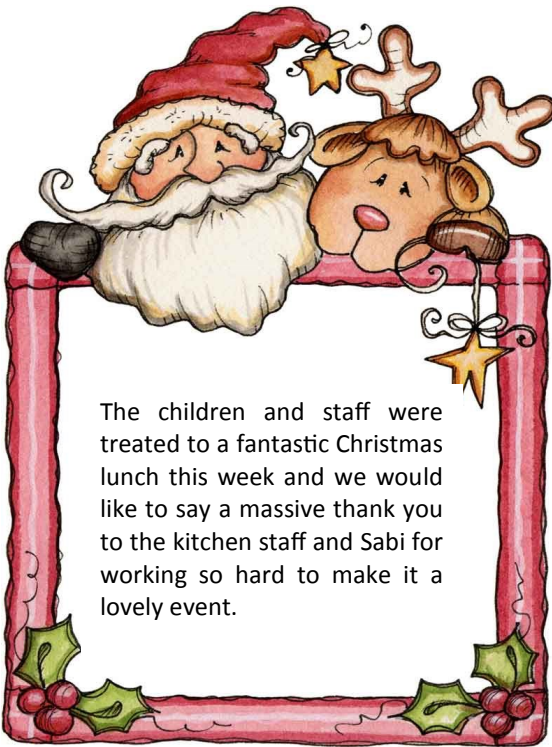




Wishing all our families a peaceful Christmas and a very happy New Year. See you all on the 4th January.

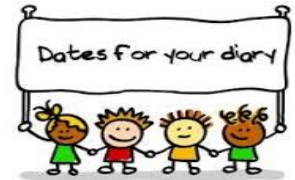
